### **Music Director**

**GENE WIE** appears internationally as a conductor, performer, and teacher of violin, viola, clarinet, and saxophone. His extensive ensemble experience has seen him in concert throughout the United States and abroad in Australia, New Zealand, France, Italy, Austria, Switzerland, Slovenia, Croatia, and the Czech Republic. Gene is Assistant Director of the South Orange County Chamber Orchestra, a founding member of the Elegie Quartet, and Concertmaster of the Blackbird Chamber Orchestra (Fullerton). In the field of Modern Dance he has improvised music for choreographers Donald McKayle, Lisa Naugle, and Bonnie Oda Homsey, working extensively with pianist/composers Alan Terricciano and Norman Beede. He is a faculty member of the Orange County High School of the Arts where he conducts the Concert Orchestra and String Orchestra, directs the String Masterclass, and teaches courses in Music Technology and Appreciation/Fundamentals. He is also involved in K-6 music curriculum development and publishing at the MusiShare Center. He works with numerous summer festivals including ChamberArtsFest (USA/France), the Viola Workout (Colorado), and Arrowbear Music Camp. A former software engineer turned musician, Gene earned B.S. Information and Computer Science and M.F.A. Music degrees from the University of California, Irvine. His mentors include William Fitzpatrick, Haroutune Bedelian, and William Kennedy (violin/viola), Amanda Walker and Dorea Tate (clarinet), and Stephen Tucker (conducting).

### **Assistant Director**

**SUSAN BUSH** currently attends the Thornton School of Music at the University of Southern California, majoring in Music Education with a performance emphasis in Violin. Previous conducting appearances include performances with the National High School Music Institute at Northwestern University in 2002 and The Four Seasons Concerto Orchestra in 2002-2003. Susan currently teaches private violin and viola lessons at the La Canada Music Studios and she is a member of the Music Educators National Conference and the California Music Educators Association. Over the summer of 2005, Susan studied Er-hu performance at the Chinese Music Summer School at the Royal Academy of Music in London, England.
