## **Music Director**

**GENE WIE** appears internationally as a conductor, performer, and teacher of violin, viola, clarinet, and saxophone. His extensive ensemble experience has seen him in concert throughout the United States and abroad in Australia, New Zealand, England, France, Italy, Austria, Switzerland, Slovenia, Croatia, and the Czech Republic. He is Concertmaster of the Fullerton Chamber Orchestra and is a member of the Elegie and Brenton String Quartets. In addition to his work with the Community Youth Orchestra of Southern California, he is the Director of the Orchestra Program at St. Margaret's Episcopal School in San Juan Capistrano, and conductor of the Concert Orchestra at the Orange County High School of the Arts where he also teaches courses in string pedagogy and music technology. As Vice President of MusiShare Inc., he is part of a industry-leading team that develops technology-driven music education solutions. In the summers he performs with and coaches chamber ensembles at Arrowbear Music Camp (California), the Viola Workout (Colorado), and ChamberArtsFest (USA/France). A former software engineer turned musician, Gene holds B.S. Information and Computer Science and M.F.A. Music degrees from the University of California, Irvine.

**SUSAN BUSH** currently attends the Thornton School of Music at the University of Southern California, majoring in Music Education with a performance emphasis in Violin.
